**GUIDELINES FOR THE ADMISSION PROCESS FOR THE APPLICANTS PROVIDED BY THE
THE UNIVERSITY OF BURDWAN**

Admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) in Self-financed Law Colleges

Session: 2022-27

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Programme in Self-financed Colleges under B.U. will start on and from 02.09.2022 following the modalities laid down therein the Govt. Notification vide no. 507-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14, dated 30.06.2022.

On completion of admission process within the specified date, classes will be commenced on and from 19.09.2022 adhering the COVID-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Govt. from time to time. Apart from this, admission to the above mentioned programme will be guided by the following guidelines:

1) Admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Programme in Self-financed Colleges under B.U. will be done through on-line mode only by the respective college authority as per the Govt. Notification vide no. 507-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14, dated 30.06.2022 and under any circumstances, no student will be admitted through off- line mode by the Self-financed Law College Authorities and in this case the University Authority shall not be responsible for Registration and Enrolment of any student if admitted, through off-line mode.

2) Application fee : Application fee is exempted for the year 2022-23.

3) On-line admission will be done based on merit. Prospective students should not be called for counselling or verification during the process of admission. No physical presence will be required at the colleges.

4) For generation of Merit List, Merit Score of each applicant will be computed taking into account [40% of Percentage Marks obtained in MP (10th Standard) / Equivalent Examination + 60% of Percentage Marks obtained in H.S. (10+2) / Equivalent Examination]. In case of tie, the marks of English at Higher Secondary or +2 Examinations will be compared and the marks of English at the Madhyamik Pariksha or its equivalent examination will be compared as the third criterion, if needed.

5) Each college authority shall have to submit weekly admission report to the university authority by mail (ic@buruniv.ac.in , secretary_ug@buruniv.ac.in).

6) Eligible applicants will be informed directly by the college authorities through e-mail and/ or tele-communication.

7) All testimonials are required to be uploaded online during application. Verification of documents will be done by the respective college only when the students will report for classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted on-line.

8) All stakeholders shall adhere to the COVID-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Govt. from time to time.

9) Candidates, engaged in any other Course of Studies shall not be allowed to pursue this programme simultaneously and in-service candidates will have to produce NOC from their employers for pursuing this course.

10) Candidates, who have passed the Higher Secondary or +2 Examination from any recognized Council/ Board/University, are eligible for application subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criterion stated below:

Eligibility: For admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Programme, each candidate shall have to pass the Higher Secondary Examination under (10+2) pattern or its equivalent examination securing not below 45% of the total marks in case of general category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.

*Note: In the calculation of percentage marks of Higher Secondary Examination under (10+2) pattern or its equivalent examination, marks of the best five subjects, available in the mark sheet, will be considered.

11) As per BCI norm, the applicants who have obtained 10+2 or Graduation/ Post Graduation through open University system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission in the law courses.

12) No age limit is there but the entire process including admission to the programme shall abide by the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in WP (Civil) No. 1023/2016 pending before it.

13) There will be no reservation in seats in Self-financed College(s) by virtue of the Sl. No. 3 in the Notification of the Kolkata Gazette, vide Registered no. WB/ SC- 247, NO. WB (Part-I)/ 2014/ SAR- 6, dated 03.01.2014.

14) Fees: Fee for pursuing this programme in the Self-financed Colleges is Rs.25,000/- per annum. In addition, a student will pay Registration fee, Enrolment fee, Center fee, etc. of the university separately.

15) In case of cancellation of admission of any student, fees will be refunded as per the relevant circulars of the UGC and the Higher Education Deptt., Govt. of West Bengal.

16) In regard to admission of students to this programme, the rules and the relevant Notifications of The University of Burdwan, The Govt. of West Bengal & The Bar Council of India shall strictly be followed by the colleges.

Apart from the above mentioned modalities and guidelines, all other relevant provisions, laid down there in the Notification, vide no. 507-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14, dated 30.06.2022, will also be followed.
