### Admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) in Self-financed Law Colleges

Session: 2021-26

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Programme in Self-financed Colleges under B.U. will start following the Govt. Notification vide no. 706-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dated 13.07.2021 and the intending candidates are directed to visit the website of the colleges concerned. The entire process of admission will be **completed** as per the following schedule:

- a) Date of opening of On-line Portal for Application for the Programme – 11.09.2021
- b) Date of Completion of Application for the Programme in the On-line Portal– 20.09.2021
- c) Date of Publication of Provisional Merit List – 21.09.2021
- d) Date of Publication of Final Merit List – 23.09.2021
- e) Date of Commencement of Admission to the Programme – 24.09.2021
- f) Date of Completion of Admission to the Programme – 30.09.2021

On completion of admission process within the specified date, classes will be commenced on and from 01.10.2021 adhering the COVID-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Govt. from time to time. Apart from this, the following guidelines, related to admission to the above mentioned programme, will be followed:

1) Admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Programme in Self-financed Colleges under B.U. will be done through on-line mode only by the respective college authority as per the Govt. Notification vide no. 706-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dated 13.07.2021 and **under any circumstances, no student will be admitted through off-line mode by the Self-financed Law College Authorities and in this case the University Authority shall not be responsible for Registration and Enrolment of any student if admitted, through off-line mode.**

2) **Application fee : Application fee is exempted for the year 2021-22.**

3) On-line admission will be done based on merit. Prospective students should not be called for counselling or verification during the process of admission. No physical presence will be required at the colleges.

4) For generation of Merit List, **Merit Score** of each applicant will be **computed** taking into account [**40% of Percentage Marks obtained in MP (10<sup>th</sup> Standard) / Equivalent Examination + 60% of Percentage Marks obtained in H.S. (10+2) / Equivalent Examination**]. In case of tie, the marks of English at Higher Secondary or +2 Examinations will be compared and the marks of English at the Madhyamik Pariksha or its equivalent examination will be compared as the third criterion, if needed.

5) Each college authority **shall have to submit weekly admission report to the university authority** by mail ([ic@buruniv.ac.in](mailto:ic@buruniv.ac.in) , [secretary\\_ug@buruniv.ac.in](mailto:secretary_ug@buruniv.ac.in)).

6) Eligible applicants will be informed directly by the college authorities through e-mail and/ or tele-communication.

7) **Payment of admission fee will be done only through e-payment or designated bank(s) [Credit Card/**

**Debit Card/ Net Banking] and not physically at the colleges.**

8) All testimonials are required to be uploaded online during application. Verification of documents will be done by the respective college only when the students will report for classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted on-line.

9) All stakeholders shall adhere to the COVID-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Govt. from time to time.

10) Candidates, engaged in any other Course of Studies shall not be allowed to pursue this programme simultaneously and in-service candidates will have to produce NOC from their employers for pursuing this course.

11) Candidates, who have passed the Higher Secondary or +2 Examination from any recognized Council/ Board/University, are eligible for application subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criterion stated below:

**Eligibility:** For admission to 5-year B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Programme, each candidate shall have to pass the Higher Secondary Examination under (10+2) pattern or its equivalent examination securing not below 45% of the total marks in case of general category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.

\*Note: In the calculation of percentage marks of Higher Secondary Examination under (10+2) pattern or its equivalent examination, marks of the best five subjects, available in the mark sheet, will be considered. Marks of Environmental Studies may be considered among the best five subjects if it is found under Compulsory Elective / Optional Elective in the Mark Sheet.

12) As per BCI norm, the applicants who have obtained 10+2 or Graduation/ Post Graduation through open University system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission in the law courses.

13) No age limit is there but the entire process including admission to the programme shall abide by the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in WP (Civil) No. 1023/2016 pending before it.

14) There will be no reservation of seats in Self-financed Law Colleges following the notification of the Kolkata Gazette, vide Registered no. WB/ SC- 247, NO. WB (Part-I)/ 2014/ SAR- 6, dated- 03.01.2014 (under sl. No. 3).

15) Fees: Fee for pursuing this programme in the Self-financed Colleges is Rs. 25,000/- per annum. In addition to that fees, a student will pay enrolment fee, centre fee, registration fee etc. of the university separately. **No college authority will charge any amount in excess of the university prescribed fees.**

16) In view of the financial hardship being faced due to lockdowns and related factors, a full refund of fees should be made on account of all cancellation of admission of any student upto 31.10.2021 for the academic year 2021-22 as a special case. It is clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (ie. there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellation of admission by 31.10.2021. Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admission upto 31.12.2021, the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not more than Rs. 1000/- as processing fee.

17) In each college, students will be admitted within the approved intake (Bengal Law College- 80 & Amex Law College- 60) only.

18) As per UGC Guidelines, each student shall have to create his / her NAD ID and it is optional at the time of admission but mandatory before the registration of the admitted candidate. In case of any query in this regard please contact the NODAL OFFICER, NAD, BU (nad@buruniv.ac.in).

19) In regard to admission of students to this programme, the rules and the relevant Notifications of The University of Burdwan, The Govt. of West Bengal & The Bar Council of India shall strictly be followed by the colleges.
